

FREE CYBER HEALTH CHECK TERMS & CONDITIONS

Application	These terms apply to any free cyber health check or preliminary cyber assessment provided by Enrizen Digital Pty Ltd (Enrizen). By requesting or participating in a cyber health check, you agree to these terms.
Scope	The cyber health check is a limited, high-level assessment based on information available at the time, including information you provide and publicly available technical, domain, website, device, usage and security information.
Not a Comprehensive Assessment	Unless agreed in writing, the cyber health check is not a penetration test, forensic investigation, managed security service, comprehensive audit, compliance certification, legal advice, financial advice, insurance advice or guarantee of security.
Authority and Accuracy	You confirm that you have authority to request the assessment and provide information relating to any relevant organisation, individual, domain, website, platform, system or network. You are responsible for ensuring the information provided is accurate, complete and not misleading.
Sensitive Credentials	Do not provide passwords, private keys, access tokens, secret keys, recovery codes or other sensitive security credentials unless Enrizen expressly requests them through an approved secure channel.
Privacy and Consent	By requesting or participating in a cyber health check, you consent to Enrizen collecting, using and disclosing business contact, technical, device, usage, security and publicly available information to conduct the assessment, identify cyber risks, prepare reports or recommendations, provide support, improve services and communicate with you about relevant Enrizen services. Personal information will be handled in accordance with Enrizen's Privacy Policy and the <i>Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)</i> .
Third-Party Tools	Enrizen may use third-party tools, platforms, software, hosting, analytics, cybersecurity and technical service providers to conduct or support the assessment. Enrizen is not responsible for third-party systems or providers except to the extent required by law.
Findings and Reliance	Findings and recommendations are for general risk awareness and internal business use only, are based on information available at the time, and may not identify all vulnerabilities, threats or risks.
No Remediation Obligation	Unless separately agreed in writing, Enrizen is not responsible for implementing, monitoring, managing or verifying any remediation action arising from the cyber health check.
Confidentiality of Report	Any report or findings are for your internal use only and must not be published, distributed, represented as certification or used in marketing material without Enrizen's prior written consent.



Marketing	Enrizen may contact you about the cyber health check and related Enrizen services. You may opt out of marketing communications at any time.
Liability and Indemnity	To the maximum extent permitted by law, Enrizen is not liable for loss arising from or in connection with a cyber health check, related findings or recommendations, or any action taken or not taken in response. You indemnify Enrizen for loss arising from any unauthorised request, breach of these terms, breach of law, infringement of third-party rights, or inaccurate, misleading or unauthorised information. Nothing excludes rights that cannot be excluded by law.
Refusal or Withdrawal	Enrizen may decline, suspend, vary or withdraw a cyber health check at any time, including where a request is inappropriate, incomplete, unauthorised, unlawful, unsafe or outside the intended scope.
Governing Law	These terms are governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia.
